Privacy Statement regarding the protection of personal data in the context of EuroCC 3 hybrid workshop “BioExcel / EuroCC Workshop on Biomolecular Simulations: Aegean Edition”

The EuroCC 3 is a project of the European High-Performance computing Joint Undertaking (JU) under grant agreement No 101306701. The National Infrastructures for Research and Technology (hereinafter referred to as “GRNET S.A.”), the Biomedical Research Foundation of the Academy of Athens (BRFAA), the BioExcel Centre of Excellence (BioExcel), the Izmir Biomedicine and Genome Center (IBG) and the Dokuz Eylul University organize the “*BioExcel / EuroCC Workshop on Biomolecular Simulations: Aegean Edition*” (hereinafter referred to as “workshop”).

Scope of this Privacy Statement:

Controllers -acting on behalf of the EuroCC 3- are bound by European Regulation 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (General Data Protection Regulation – hereinafter referred to as “**the GDPR**”) and Law 4624/2019 (Government Gazette 137/A/2019) on “*Data Protection Authority, measures for the implementation of Regulation(EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and for the incorporation into national law of Directive(EU) 2016/680 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 and other provisions*”, as in force at any time (hereinafter referred to as “the Law”). This Privacy Statement details all information necessary for the processing of personal data for the “workshop”, as well as the policies and procedures implemented by the Controllers for the protection of the user’s privacy. This

Privacy Statement sets out the criteria as well as the terms and conditions under which the Controllers collect, process, use, store and transmit the personal data of the project users, how they ensure the confidentiality of such information, including any law and/or regulation implemented or enacted in accordance with Union and national laws on personal data protection and electronic privacy, as well as any law and/or regulation amending, replacing, issuing or consolidating any of the latter, including any other applicable EU and national laws on the processing of personal data and privacy, which may exist in accordance with applicable law.

For the purposes of this Privacy Statement, the terms “data processor”, “data controller”, “third party”, “supervising authority”, “personal data”, “processing”, “data subject” shall have the meaning ascribed to them by applicable legislation on the protection of personal data.

In addition, for the purposes of the present, the following definitions shall also apply:

“Website” – the website accessible via domain name <https://events.grnet.gr/event/211/> including the entirety of it.

“User”- the EuroCC 3 “workshop” user, whom the data refer to, whose identity is known or may be verified, namely it may be directly or indirectly determined.

A. Purpose/s for processing the data collected:

Controllers -acting on behalf of the EuroCC 3- within the framework of the “workshop” collect and process the personal data of the persons who give their consent, for the following purpose / purposes:

1. To registered in the “workshop”.
2. For the implementation of the online event using the "zoom" platform.
3. For the implementation of the sending of messages and the technical support of the project by the executor "Moosend Ltd".
4. For the photography and the videography of the workshop
5. Promotion of the “workshop”

Controllers -acting on behalf of the EuroCC 3- collect and processes “users” personal data in the context of providing the “workshop” solely for the abovementioned purposes and only to the extent strictly necessary to effectively serve such purposes. These data shall be relevant, appropriate and not more than those required in view of the aforementioned purposes. They shall also be accurate and, if necessary, updated.

Furthermore, the aforementioned data shall be retained only during the period required as mentioned hereinabove, in order to accomplish the purposes of their collection and processing and shall be deleted after the end thereof (see below “Personal data retention periods”).

B. Categories of personal data processed:

In the context of contact for the online event and for following information, the personal data that are being processed are:

1. To register in the “workshop”.
 - Name
 - Last name
 - Gender (female, male, non-binary, other, prefer not to say) - (for statistical purpose only)
 - Email address
 - Organization/Company/Institution
 - Position (Undergraduate student, MSc Student, PhD Student, Post-Doc, Principal Investigator (PI)), Type of Attendance (On site, Online)
 - Letter From PI

- Motivation Letter & CV
 - How did you find out about the event (BioExcel Website, LinkedIn Page, BlueSky, X, YouTube, Supervisor, Other)?
2. For the implementation of the online event using the "zoom" platform:
 - Username
 - Password
 - The video and audio streaming of the online event
 - The IP address wherefrom the “user” connects to the platform
 - Connecting device details (device type, manufacturer, model, operating system)
 - Country
 - Total time of being connected
 - Questions you ask through the platform
 3. For the implementation of the sending of messages and the technical support of the project by the processor "Moosend Ltd" the personal data being processed are:
 - Name
 - Last name
 - Email address,
 - Organization/Company
 - Role in the Organization/Institution
 - Responses to participating in accepted events
 - History of emails that have been sent
 4. For the photography and videography of the “workshop”
 - Photographs
 - Video
 5. For the promotion of the “workshop” the following personal data of the participants (Photos, videos) will be published on the following social media:

C. Legal bases for processing

For the aforementioned purposes, processing of users’ personal data is based on the provision of the data subject’s consent, as required by Article 6 par. 1 par. A of GDPR.

In particular, with regard to the processing of personal data for archiving purposes, the legal basis of the overriding legitimate interest of the Controllers -acting on behalf of the EuroCC 3- and/or EuroCC 3 applies (Art. 6 para f’ GDPR). This aims to creating and maintaining the company's/consortium's/entity's historical archive and historical identity.

D. Access to personal data:

For the implementation of the dispatch and processing of the “workshop” access to the personal data of “users” is provided to the following:

- The EuroCC 3 project marketing team of GRNET S.A., which consists of staff that maintains a contractual relationship of project leasing and provision of services with GRNET S.A.
- The staff of BRFAA that maintain a contractual relationship.
- The staff of BioExcel that maintain a contractual relationship.
- The staff of IBG that maintain a contractual relationship.
- Associates of GRNET S.A., who are bound by a private confidentiality agreement with GRNET S.A.:
 - The staff of the company “Moosend Ltd” in case of technical support.
 - The staff of the company “Zoom” in case of technical support and for the provision of the platform.

The processing of the “workshop” “users” personal data by the aforementioned, is carried out under the supervision of the Controllers -acting on behalf of the EuroCC 3- within the scope of the mission and the role of each associate. The associates undertake to comply with the same privacy and personal data requirements as the data controllers in accordance to the present Privacy Statement.

E. Recipients of collected personal data:

Controllers -acting on behalf of the EuroCC 3- shall in no way transmit or in any way disclose the “users” personal data to any third-party entities, private businesses, natural persons or legal entities, public authorities, agencies or other organizations, other than as expressly set out herein.

The “users” personal data may be disclosed or transmitted to governmental authorities and/or law enforcement officials, only if necessary for the abovementioned purposes, in the context of enforcement of a court decision or a provision of law or if necessary to secure the legitimate interests of the Controllers -acting on behalf of the EuroCC 3- in compliance with the terms and conditions of applicable law.

F. Rights of data subject

As regards the data processed in the context of providing the “workshop” Controllers -acting on behalf of the EuroCC 3- take all necessary action, pursuant to the terms of this Privacy Statement, both during the collection as well as in every subsequent stage of processing of the online event “users” personal data, so that every “user” may exercise his/her rights, as laid out in applicable legislation on the protection of personal data, namely the rights of Access, Rectification, Erasure, Restriction of Processing, data Portability, as detailed hereinbelow and in accordance with the terms and conditions of applicable law:

- **Right of access:** The data subject is entitled to request and obtain from the Controllers -acting on behalf of the EuroCC 3- a confirmation on whether or not his/her personal data are processed and, if so, to exercise the right to access such personal data pursuant to applicable legislation. The data subject may also request a copy of the personal data undergoing processing, as described in this Privacy Statement. Finally, it should be noted that the right to obtain a copy of the personal data undergoing processing shall not adversely affect the rights and freedoms of others in accordance with applicable law.
- **Right of rectification:** The data subject shall have the right to request from the Controllers -acting on behalf of the EuroCC 3- to rectify any inaccurate personal data concerning him/her. Considering the purposes of the processing, the data subject shall have the right to request that any incomplete personal data be completed, including by means of providing a supplementary statement, in accordance with applicable legislation.

- **Right of erasure:** The data subject has the right to delete all his/her personal data that have been collected and processed in the context of his/her participation in the “workshop” in accordance with the terms of the current legislation and the terms of this.
- **Right to restriction of processing:** The data subject is entitled to ensure that the Controllers -acting on behalf of the EuroCC 3- restrict the processing of his/her data, if any of the conditions laid down by applicable legislation on the protection of personal data, is met.
- **Right to data portability:** The data subject has the right to obtain any personal data concerning him/her, which he/she has provided to the Controllers -acting on behalf of the EuroCC 3- in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, as well as the right to transmit such data to another data processor, without any objection from the processor to which the personal data have been provided, in accordance with the provisions of the applicable legislation on personal data.
- **Withdrawal of consent:** In addition, data subjects have the right, at any time, to withdraw their consent, without this withdrawal affecting the lawfulness of the processing that took place prior to its withdrawal.

For example, in the event that a subject has given their consent for the collection and (re)publication of photographic/video material and this material is published/posted on the social media as described on this document, in case withdraw their consent, then the Controllers -acting on behalf of the EuroCC 3- will not (re)publish any new posts of the photographic/video material in question; However, it should be noted that in this case, regardless of the intentions of the Controllers -acting on behalf of the EuroCC 3-, the Controllers will not be able to control any republications of the material in question by third parties or the retention of the material in question on social media.

It is also clarified that any withdrawal of consent by the data subject does not affect the right of the Controllers -acting on behalf of the EuroCC 3- (as mentioned above) on the legal basis of its legitimate interest, to retain the relevant photographic/video material for archival purposes and to preserve their historical identity.

The aforementioned rights of the data subjects are subject to restrictions in accordance with the applicable legislation.

The Controllers -acting on behalf of the EuroCC 3- provide the data subject with information on the action taken upon his request to exercise any of the above rights within one (1) month of receipt of the request. The aforementioned deadline may be extended by two (2) more months, in accordance with the terms of the existing legislation.

G. Personal data retention period

The personal data collected and processed in the context of registering for the “workshop”, based on the consent of the data subjects, will be retained until the withdrawal of their consent or until the request for deletion is exercised. At any time, the withdrawal of consent will be possible here by completing these forms (Registration, Photos/Videos).

It is mentioned that in this case, the legitimacy of the processing of personal data that took place in the context of the given previous consent is not affected.

In any case, the retention period, shall not exceed the period of two (2) years after the completion of the “workshop”.

Photographic/video material that may be kept by the Controllers -acting on behalf of the EuroCC 3- for archival purposes and to preserve their historical identity is kept without time limitation, without further processing.

Finally, photographic/video material posted social media is kept online, in accordance with the data retention rules of those social media.

H. Technical and Organisational Measures:

The processing of personal data by the Controllers -acting on behalf of the EuroCC 3- is carried out in such a way as to ensure its confidentiality and security. Specifically, it is carried out exclusively by authorized associates of the Controllers -acting on behalf of the EuroCC 3- while all appropriate organizational and technical measures are taken for data security and protection against accidental or unlawful destruction, accidental loss, alteration, prohibited dissemination or access and any other form of unfair treatment.

The “Moosend” -acting as data processor- maintains its servers in a data center within the European Union. Takes all appropriate organizational and technical measures for the security of the data and their protection against accidental or unlawful destruction, accidental loss, alteration, prohibited dissemination or access and any other form of unfair processing.
